SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

The following classes are offered in each sex:

Puppy: 6 Months & Under 9 Months Puppy: 9 Months & Under 12 Months Senior: 12 Months & Under 18 Months

The sweepstakes will be open to all Miniature Bull Terriers, who on the day of the show will be at least 6 months and under 18 months of age. No dog that is a "CHAMPION OF RECORD" may compete. Each dog must be entered a regular class. Entries are to be made at the same time and on the same form as the entries for the regular classes. Sweepstakes classes should be indicated in the area marked "additional classes" on the entry form.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran dogs do not need to be entered in a regular class. <u>Sweepstakes classes should be indicated in the area marked "additional classes" on entry form.</u>

The following classes are offered in each sex:

Veteran: 7 Years & Under 9 Years Veteran: 9 Years & Under 12 Years

Veteran: 12 Years & Older

Prize money for Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes in each class will be based on a percentage of entry fees in that class divided as follows:

First Prize 30% Third Prize 10% Second Prize 20% Fourth Prize 5%

35% Will be retained by Club for expenses.

STUD DOG/BROOD BITCH COMPETITION

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Classes – no less than two and no more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs/Brood Bitches must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Get/Produce. Entry to be judged only based on the merits of the Get/Produce. While the merits of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed. Get/Produce MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition in the National Specialty, October 29,2025. Entry fee is \$35.00 if Stud Dog/Brood Bitch is **NOT** entered in the classes at the National Specialty. If shown in the classes at the National Specialty, the entry fee is \$15.00 as an additional class. Notation must be made on entry form.



A class for entries of three dogs, regardless of sex, representing three consecutive generations (grandparent, parent, offspring). The youngest offspring must be entered in a regular class (parent and grandparent need not be entered in any other class). Youngest offspring must enter Generations class on the entry form (Additional Classes). The parent and grandparent may be altered. The entry is judged as a unit. All are judged on how well they represent the ideal of the breed standard. The quality of each dog should meet or exceed the quality of each preceding generation. The judge may make allowances for maturity based upon the age of an entry. Placements will include winner and runner-up.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE: (919) 233-9767. For additional information contact American Kennel Club, Junior Showmanship, P.O. Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675-9051. Phone (919) 233-9767 or E-mail: juniors@akc.org.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Beginner Puppies

(4-6 months of age) AKC Sanctioned Beginner Puppy Competition!

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*

PEE WEE SPECIAL ATTRACTION

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate in the Pee Wee Class Special Attraction.

The safety of the children is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the
 eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- At a Group or Specialty Club Show the dogs must be of the breed(s) eligible for the event.
- A dog must be registered to participate.
- Entry must pre entered and stated in the additional class box on the AKC entry form.

In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Release form will be available from the show secretary at the event prior to judging.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience—no Junior / Pee Wee will be "judged" but

rather will be mentored with the age-appropriate amount of information to

help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. Obviously, the older children can absorb more detail than the younger ones. The children will be mentored one child, their adult, and dog in the ring at a time. Each child will receive a participation ribbon or rosette to

commemorate the experience.

The Judge should explain the process of showing the dog to the Junior and the responsible adult in the ring including breed specific

presentation.

Depending on the size of the dog and the child, the adult may be asked to lift a table breed on or off the table, or the Club may mandate that the adult should do it regardless. .
